- Ed Hatgas and Kari Baciak attended the Tree City USA awards ceremony. We were awarded the Growth Award for the third year in a row.

- There is a Rain Barrel workshop on June 21st at our Community Center. This is open to anyone.
- Eleven residents have been notified to get their grass cut and ten others are being monitored.
- Chief Stefanko reminded council that the Fire Department will be spending the budget allowed money for clothing.

#### POLICE CHIEF

- Park Security began on May 1<sup>st</sup> and the golf cart is in action. Commended CB Graphics, Chuck Johnson for the graphics.
- There is no handicap parking by diamond 2. The Park Security will shuttle handicapped from the bottom of the hill to diamond 2.

- All of our officers participated in Active Shooter Training on April 29<sup>th</sup> at Cinemark in Valley View.
  The object of this training was to integrate the Fire Departments so that they can get in quicker and begin treatment before people bleed out.
- The Fire Departments are receiving entry vests and helmets.
- The Chief's car was repaired from the April 18<sup>th</sup> incident and he was rear-ended last night. The damage is \$500 and he is waiting to hear from the other driver's insurance company.
- The LPL phone outside the station needs to be replaced. The cost is about \$600 and Cox Communications will do the installation.
- The department will be doing a "side arms" replacement. The cost of the new guns would be abut \$650 each and with trade-in will cost us about \$100 each.
- MOTION: Mr. Black moved to pay Taser Assurance Plan \$1,110 for the contract for six of the fourteen tasers. Second by Mr. Walsh Motion carried 5-0

### SERVICE DIRECTOR

- Recycling is down a fraction this year but we did not collect as much Household Hazardous Waste or old computers.
- Beginning June 1<sup>st</sup> the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District will no longer take fluorescent bulbs. If residents bring them to the Service Garage we will collect them and dispose of them. We will have to pay to do this.
- MOTION: Mr. Foote moved to pay the State of Ohio Underground Storage Tanks invoice in the amount of \$1,800. Second by Mr. Walsh Motion carried 5-0 (This is for the gas tanks behind the Service Garage and must be paid each year)
- The road salt agreement next year will be at \$52.29 per ton (down \$1 a ton) through the consortium. We are storing 250 tons and are committed to purchase another 250 tons by December 31, 2017.
- MOTION: Mr. Foote moved to pay Adelmo Plumbing \$1,610 to repair the faucet (flagged by the Health Department) in the ladies jail. Second by Mr. Walsh Motion carried 5-0
- MOTION: Mr. Lahiff moved to pay Adelmo Plumbing \$1,560 to clean-out and replace the drain in the Ladies jail cell. Second by Mr. Black Motion carried 5-0

Per the Real Estate Transfer Agreement dated February 22, 2009, we are hereby giving notice that West Creek is creating severe damage to the south shore embankment of West Creek adjacent to and contiguous to our property at 990 Resource Drive.

In the past several days we have monitored and documented approximately five (5) feet of bank erosion. Said damage presents an immediate and serious threat to our improvements and your immediate action is required per the above mentioned agreement. It is clear that water in the creek is being diverted onto the south embankment and is causing the damage. Any delay in repairs could cause very significant damage to our property and the improvements thereon.
