#### FIRE DEPARTMENT

 Asst. Chief Lasky told council that the four (4) new police officers were trained last evening in "Stop the Bleed, CPR and NARCAN" by himself, Chief Stefanko and Parma UH. Asst. Chief Lasky commended the department and the new officers for their diligence, enthusiasm and service to the village.

### **MAYOR'S REPORT**

- We have collected 15.7% more income that planned. Year to Date we are at \$6,194,357 or \$788,591 ahead of the plan and 20% more than 2020. In 2020 we collected \$5,275,638 so we are ahead year to date over 2020 by \$918,719.
- The Family Fun Day sponsored by the Park Board on October 9<sup>th</sup> was a success. The village
  picks up the cost for safety and security so the village will pay the cost of the extra porta-potties at
  a cost of \$585.
- A letter was mailed to all the residents with updates on the special Health Department Board
  meeting regarding the dump situation. The board revoked the expansion permit at RKDF and is
  unanimous in our right to NOT have another new landfill in the village.
- Halloween will be on October 31<sup>st</sup> from 6-8 pm.
- The NOPEC meeting will be virtual on Nov. 9th.
- Attended a meeting at Progressive Field to meet with the staff of the (Indians) Guardians and Armond Budish to discuss the financing of the \$208 million upgrade. The Guardians will pick-up what is not covered in the agreement and will then sign a long term lease taking them to 2036 with a potential 10 year extension to 2046.
