The purpose of the Ordinance Committee meeting was to discuss updating the ordinance relating to residential driveways. Council Member Presot opened the floor for discussion.

Assistant Building Official Howard Sonenstein outlined our current residential driveway legislation:

- At this time we do not have anything in our ordinance to restrict the size of a driveway and/or having an entire front or back yard paved.
- My recommendation is to have a maximum of eight feet and that it should be tapered to the sidewalk area.
- If a resident requests a larger drive or concrete area, they would have the ability to appeal to the Zoning Board for a variance.
- It was agreed to update the ordinance for paved areas in the front yard not to exceed a 10' width.
