 According to the law, we must advertise the property for sale for five weeks in a widely read
 newspaper. Mayor Procuk instructed the Clerk/Treasurer and council to determine the cost to
 advertise the property to sell.
- Senior snow plow season is coming soon and we are in the 3rd year of a 3-year contract. Mayor Procuk said that at 60 homes to be plowed we would collect \$8,500 and pay the contractor \$13,500. The village is responsible for the \$4,950 difference. All of council is ok with the current pricing to the seniors and the cost of the contract.
