The purpose of the Building Committee meeting was to discuss repairs to the elevators.

- Mr. Berzins reported that we may need to plan on these repairs being put in next year's budget. The cost is \$80-\$90,000 for the municipal building elevator and the community center elevator is also showing its age.
- Mr. Frank shared that we have \$5,000 in NOPEC funds that can be used toward the repairs and we may get another \$5,000 next year from them.
- Mr. Florjancic explained that the controllers are obsolete and the hydraulic systems are outdated.
- How to finance the project, the availability of grant dollars and being ADA compliant was discussed.
- Mayor Procuk encouraged that we get prices on fixing both elevators. Mr. Florjancic will get the estimates and report back to council.

There were no further questions and the meeting was adjourned.
