These proceeds went directly to the Park Board organization, which funds the Breeze, Easter Egg Hunt, Summer Community Picnic, Fall Bonfire, and Christmas Stocking events. Without the support of our sponsors and participants last year, these events would have been at risk for cancellation this year.
