The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the crosswalk near Diamond #2.

Council Member Presot opened the meeting reviewing prior meeting notes and ideas. She has spoken with our police and fire chiefs, our engineer and the service department.

- The fire chief believes that they may cause more harm than good and everyone else seems to feel it is a gray area and unsure what is necessary.
- The Service Department painted the entire area clearly defining the parking area.
- There is asphalt repair that could be done and we will get an estimate on the repair including speed bumps at the stop signs.
- The current, temporary speed bumps would easily shift and have to be reset.
- There was discussion that the delineators and too much signage become more of a distraction.
- Mr. Berzins shared information from a friend in the safety business and he suggests speed bumps for our particular situation. They feel delineators can be a tripping hazard and must be put away after games to avoid vandalism.
- Guest Ms. Kovar stated there has been two incidents and questioned the lack of urgency on this matter.
- History has shown that most of the people violating the safety rules are our own residents.
- Mayor Procuk shared that now have police officers monitoring the park and enforcement is key.
- Engineer, Mike Henry will get quotes together and schedule a follow up meeting.

Council Member Presot asked if there was any other business to discuss at the Safety Meeting. If there is no further business the meeting is adjourned.
