- Council decided to hold off until June to put funds into the Capital Improvement Fund.
- The goal is to have \$250,000 in the Capital fund by the end of the year.
- Ms. Salem said that the funds can be earmarked in the General Fund for specific accounts without all the paperwork.
- Mayor Procuk would like to see the ordinance process begin in March so that the residents can see that council is attempting to do as they promised when the tax increase passed.
