The purpose of the Parks, Playground, and Community Services Committee meeting was to discuss the CDSG Grant for Dorset Mini Park, and if Council would be willing to submit a match.

- Ms. Zoldak stated that the grant we're applying for is for \$50,000 and the quote for the pickle ball court is \$60,000. The question she had for Council is would they be willing to submit a match towards what they get from the county. She suggested a 50% match so they can do more at the park.
- Mr. Walsh asked if the money would be just for the pickle ball court or for other things they're looking into doing at the park. Ms. Zoldak responded that they could do the pickle ball court for about \$60,000 and if they were to do a 50% match they could do something more. She stated that they don't have to put exactly what equipment they are going to purchase, just that they are going to be putting in local funds as well. Mr. Tommer stated that residents in that area have told him they would like to see a kickball or whiffle ball court put in. They went on to discuss doing this in phases, and the possibility of putting in playground equipment or parking. Mr. Blados talked about possibly putting in a mountain bike trail in the area that is not fit to build on. Mr. Frank suggested hiking as well.
- Mr. Tommer said the residents in that area were telling him how they would like a whiffle ball court or a kickball field.
