#### HOLIDAY SAFETY TIPS FOR SAFE AND HAPPY HOLIDAYS

This holiday season, don't let the spirit of giving lull you into giving burglars, muggers & pickpockets a better chance to do their dirty work. Crooks love the holidays as much as everyone else, but chiefly because it's an opportune time for crime.

Homes jam-packed with glittering gifts. Stores, malls & downtown streets teaming with unsuspecting shoppers. People rushing around, stressed out & careless, looking for last minute gifts, trying to get everything done. It's enough to make a crook giddy with holiday joy. Here are some tips on how to celebrate safety this holiday season.

#### **IF YOU ARE TRAVELING**

- Get an automatic timer for your lights.
- Ask a neighbor to watch your home, shovel snow & park in the driveway from time to time.
- Don't forget to have mail & newspaper delivery stopped. If it piles up. it's a sure sign you're gone.

#### IF YOU ARE OUT FOR THE EVENING

- Turn on lights & a radio or TV so it looks like someone's home.
- Be cautious about locking doors & windows when you leave, even it it's just for a few minutes.
- Don't display gifts where they can be seen from outside.

#### **IF YOU ARE SHOPPING**

- Stay alert & be aware of what's going on around you.
- Park in a well-lighted space & be sure to lock the car, close the windows, & hide shopping bags & gifts in the trunk.
- Avoid carrying large amounts of cash. Pay with a check or credit card whenever possible.
- Deter pickpockets & purse snatchers. Don't over-burden yourself with packages. Be extra careful
  with purses & wallets. Carry a purse close to your body, not dangling by the straps. Put a wallet
  in an inside coat or front pocket.
- Shopping with kids? Teach them to go to a store clerk or security guard if you get separated.

#### IF A STRANGER COMES TO THE DOOR

- Criminals sometimes pose as couriers delivering gifts. And it's not uncommon for people to try to
  take advantage of others' generosity during the holidays by going door-to-door for charitable
  donations when there's no charity involved. Ask for identification & find out how the funds will be
  used. If you aren't satisfied, don't give. Help a charitable organization you know & like instead.
- Last but not least, don't let holiday stress get the best of your holiday spirit. Make time to get together with family, friends & neighbors. And think about reaching out in the spirit of the season & helping someone who's less fortunate or lonely.
- Do your part to make the holidays a safe & happy time for everybody. .. Except criminals.

#### TAKE A HOLIDAY INVENTORY

The holidays are a good time to update - or create - your home inventory. Take photos or make videos of items & list descriptions & serial numbers. If your home is burglarized, having a detailed inventory can help identify stolen items & make insurance claims easier to file. Make sure things like TV's, VCRs, stereo equipment, cameras, camcorders, sports equipment, jewelry, silver, computers, home office equipment & power tools are on the list. Remember to check it twice!

Applications are available for the State of Ohio HEAP Energy Assistance program which provides a one-time benefit to your main heating source. It also qualifies you for




