The Cuyahoga County Board of Elections is seeking individuals willing to work the March 17, 2020 Primary Election. We have multiple opportunities available for participation:

Voting Location Manager - \$200

Voting Location Managers (VLMs) oversee all activities within their polling location on Election Day. They assign and delegate duties to each PEO, serve as an on-site Election Equipment expert and are the point of contact with the Board of Elections. Hours begin at 5:30am and conclude when all Election Day supplies are returned to their assigned drop-off location.

Voting Location Deputy - \$200

Voting Location Deputies (VLDs) oversee all activities in their polling location and serve as the lead worker in assisting provisional voters. In the absence of the Voting Location Manager, the Deputy will assume their responsibilities in the polling location. Hours begin at 5:30am and conclude when all Election Day supplies are returned to their assigned drop-off location.

Precinct Election Official - \$172.10

Precinct Election Officials' day begins at 5:30am when they report to their assigned polling location to set up for the open of polls at 6:30am. Throughout the day, they will assist voters with the election process, including check-in and directing voters in the scanning of their ballots. The day concludes after the polls are closed and supplies are packed up. All PEO's are required to attend a training class and work on Election Day.

Election Substitute Official - up to \$202.10

Election Substitute Officials report to the Board of Elections Warehouse at 5:15am and are dispatched to polling locations throughout the county based on the needs of precincts that have workers who were unable to report to their Election Day assignments. If a substitute is not dispatched, they will be released at 9:00am and compensated \$100 for their time. Pay will be \$202.10 if they are given an assignment.

Drop-off Assistants - \$65

Drop-Off Assistants help Rovers fulfill duties, load and unload supplies from ballot transportation vehicles, safeguard sensitive documents, and perform all other duties as assigned. Minimum requirements include the ability to lift up to 70lbs consistently. Hours begin at 6:00am on Election Day until complete.

Election Transport Official - \$15.00 per hr. (\$60 minimum)

Election Transport Officials are essential for keeping political balance. They ride with law enforcement officials to and from drop-off locations and the Board of Elections warehouse to deliver ballots and materials the evening of Election Day. Each vehicle is staffed with one Democrat and one Republican. Hours begin at 6 PM on Election Day. End time varies. Earn \$60 minimum.

Rover - \$11.50 per hr.

Rovers travel to various polling locations to assess and assist with issues related to the voting process, safeguard sensitive materials, deliver election-related supplies to polling locations, and assist Precinct Election Officials when there is a high volume of voters. Rovers accumulate 20-30 hours during the two-day period, Election Day eve and Election Day.
