The Dorset, Lancaster Mural Road Reconstruction was a project performed in the southern area of the Village, which includes the replacement of approximately 7,000 square yards of pavement. This project was the second phase of the original Lancaster Road Replacement performed in 2011. The first phase improved the street within the industrial area north of I-480 and the second phase was performed within the residential area. In order to make the Village's capital improvement fund go further, the Village made application to the Ohio Public Works Commission for funding. Through patience and determination, the Village was able to secure 70% of the funding through grants and 0% loans. After the funding was secured, the Village's administration work together to plan, execute and communicate so the project was completed under the contract price and on schedule.
