



## Daylight-Saving Time Ends

Dear Village Residents,

The Brooklyn Heights Fire Department reminds you to change your smoke detector batteries as you reset your clocks from daylight savings time on Sunday, November 5, 2023. The time changes in the fall and spring coincide with recommended battery life of a smoke detector. As part of our ongoing effort to ensure that every village household has a working smoke detector, the Fire Department will accept any resident's request to have their smoke detector batteries replaced. **More importantly, if you do not have a working smoke detector or if it is more than ten years old, please purchase one and we will install it for you (excluding installations for Point of Sale or Rental Inspections).** The newer detectors are sealed and should last for ten years. To sign up, please fill out the form below and drop it in the payment box located to the left of the main entrance of the Municipal Center (345 Tuxedo Ave.) or drop it off at the Fire Station and I will contact you to schedule a date and time.
